- Fall open houses (if applicable)

November

- Fall recruitment ends
- 1st batch of decisions go out

December

- December LSAT administered
- Ongoing file review and decisions

January

- Ongoing file review and decisions
- Prepare for spring recruitment events, e.g., Admitted Students' weekends/days
- Prepare for spring open houses (if applicable)

February – April

- February LSAT administered
- Programming for admitted students events (yield events)
- Ongoing file review and decisions
- April deposit due dates

May – July

- June LSAT administered
- Managing Waitlist
- May deposit due dates/Schools with 2nd deposits
- Begin prepping for fall logistics (e.g. flex app, prospect communications, on-and-off-campus events)
- Summer yield event continues
